#### History

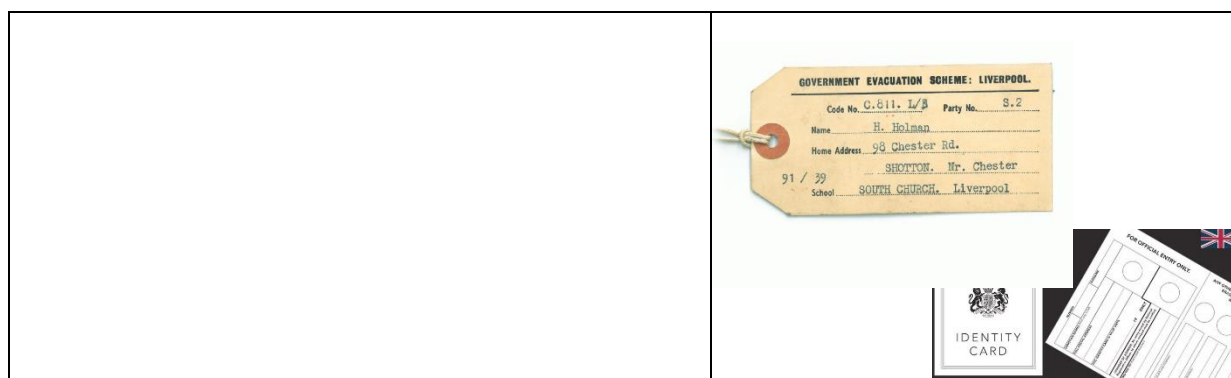

You were only allowed to take one small suitcase with you when you were evacuated. Design and make a suitcase and decided what you would take with you if you were being evacuated. Explain your reasons why you would take these items.

Create your own identity card and label.



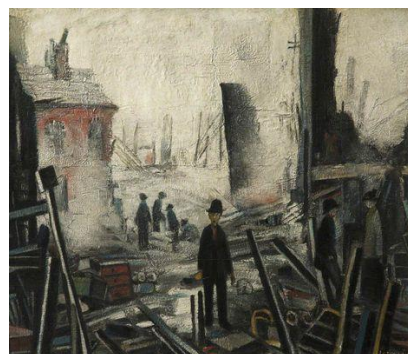
## Music
