Dear Parents

On Tuesday 31st March class 4 will be visiting the Living History Museum of Beamish in County Durham. This trip provides the children with a valuable learning experience where they will explore and empathise with different lifestyles and inventions, throughout the Victorian period, whilst considering the impact they had not only in our own country but across the globe.

A voluntary contribution of £15 to cover the cost of the coach, and entry into the museum would be very much appreciated. Friends of school have made a donation towards the transport to help keep costs to a minimum and I'm sure you will join me in thanking them. These experiences provide an invaluable enrichment for our children and could not go ahead without the continued support of the 'Friends' and yourselves. If we don't have enough contributions, the trip will have to be cancelled. Please pay and give consent using the usual method of ParentPay.

We will leave school at 8.00am precisely and hope to arrive at Beamish at approximately 10.15am. Therefore children will need to arrive at school at 7.45am prompt.

Children will need a snack for break, a packed lunch and separate tea with plenty to drink. This needs to be put into a rucksack as the children will need to carry their lunch. We will have tea on the bus on the way back. Children will also need sensible clothing (this doesn't have to be school uniform) which will dry quickly if it is wet, as well as suitable footwear and a shower proof coat, for we will be out of doors for a large part of the day.

If you would like to order a school packed lunch, please make your choice of sandwich filling: cheese, tuna or ham in the notes section of ParentPay by Monday 23rd March.

We will leave Beamish at approximately 4:30pm at the latest and hope to arrive back at school by 7pm. If you wish, children may bring up to £5 pocket money to spend in the shop.

If your child needs travel sickness medication please make sure this is handed to the class teacher in an envelope with the dosage clearly marked.
