

## Art - Week 2

Look at the powerpoint - What can you remember about how artists create the illusion of depth and distance in art? Invite children to share their ideas. [L]  
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Explain that in the 17th century, Dutch painters started to apply the rules of perspective to interiors as well as exteriors to create realistic-looking rooms. Go through the examples on the slides. [L]  
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Go through the tips on the slides for how to use vanishing points to create realistic rooms and how to use lines as guides for creating accurate perspective. [L]  
[SEP] Allow children to explore this and copy the lines creating perspective.

Take children to somewhere in the house where they have a view of a hallway or rooms leading from one to the other. Challenge children to draw what they can see, keeping in mind how to use a vanishing point to create perspective.
