History

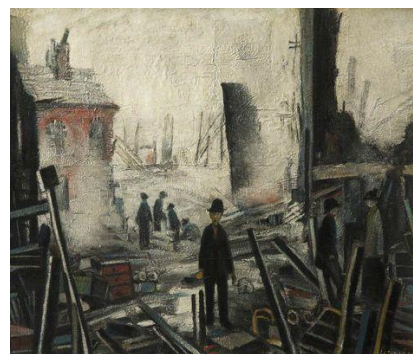
