<u>Social Media</u>

As I know many of us use social media to communicate, and it is a valuable and sometimes essential way to get messages across, I would however like to bring your attention to the following:

Parents of children in North Yorkshire schools are increasingly using social networking sites such as Facebook to talk to their friends. Sometimes parents have used these sites to criticise or make inappropriate comments about schools or even individual teachers.

Making defamatory comments on the internet has exactly the same serious legal consequences as if they are made directly to someone else. Legal action could be taken against the person who has made the online comment. Similarly threats of violence can lead to criminal proceedings under the Malicious Communications Act 1988.

If you have any concerns about anything which happens in school please speak to your child's class teacher or the Headteacher who will do their best to resolve things.

The school will always listen to your concerns and would prefer that any issues you feel you have about school are dealt with using the correct procedure. First by speaking to your child's class teacher, then myself; if you are still unhappy we have a complaints procedure which will ensure that your concerns are investigated thoroughly and appropriate action taken.

Tyre Park and Playground Equipment

As many will have seen we have a lovely new addition to our playground. At the end of last term a tyre park was added to the playground for the children to use for balance and agility, as well as an all weather surface under the trim trail.
