



Dear Parents and Carers,

Santa and his elves have been busy preparing some gifts for our Elf Shelf Christmas Shop. They have all been careful to wash their hands, wear masks and keep 2 metres away from each other in Santa's workshop.

The gifts will be available to buy in school on **Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> December**. There will be a variety of gifts suitable for mums, dads, nanas, grandads, aunties and uncles.

The children will be shown into the shop in their class bubbles to purchase the gifts by their teachers and teaching assistants.
