I hope you have been enjoying the lovely weather we have had over the Easter break and are safe and well.

The staff have been preparing home learning packs and work for the next two weeks. Each class has put relevant work on the school's website for all to access, including all the PowerPoints, links to websites and specific resources children will need. Any resources that needed to be printed will be available for collection, where possible, on Tuesday 21st April from school. To ensure we abide by the government social distancing guidelines, we have put the following procedure in place:

- A pack, if you require one, will be made available on Tuesday 21st April for your child.
- Please enter the site via the pedestrian gate on Broadmanor and leave through the vehicle gate (Nursery gates will be open). No vehicles will be accessing the site during the day.
- The packs will be placed on a class table on the Broadmanor playground. A member of staff will be present if you have any questions.
- Each class will have an allocated time slot to pick up the pack; this ensures a limited amount of people on site at any one time.
- If you have more than one child in school and they are in different classes, you will be able to pick up all the packs at once.
- If someone else will be picking up a pack for your child, please let us know.

If you are unable to collect the work on Tuesday or at the time allocated, please let the school know and we will try to make alternative arrangements for you to get a pack.

The work set is based on what they would have been completing in school. We would appreciate it if completed work could be photographed and emailed to the school.

At present, the Government has said that the current regulations will be in place for a further three weeks. The school will continue to provide educational learning activities for the children to complete at home until the school reopens. If you require any additional
