Dear Parents

We hope you have had a lovely summer break and enjoyed some good quality time with your families. Mrs Rayner and I would like to thank everyone for their good wishes and lovely gifts at the end of the summer term, they were very much appreciated and well received.

The children have settled well into class 4 and are working hard. Adults supporting class 4 this year are Mrs Rayner and Mrs Barrow.

PE takes place every Wednesday and Friday and children may come to school in their PE kits. PE kits must adhere to school uniform which is dark shorts and a white top. Tracksuits may be worn in the colder weather and again must be appropriate (no designer or football club etc. logos).

Homework club takes place in the library every Tuesday lunchtime with Mrs Smith. Please establish good homework routines with your child. If a child is stuck they can always bring their homework to myself or Mrs Rayner (before the day it is due in) and we will help, but homework set must be completed.

Home-time is busy with many people on site. Please can you make sure that the classroom door area and pathway is clear so that I can ensure the safety of the children and safe delivery to parents.
