Answer the comprehension questions for Chapter the whole book – what can you remember? The questions are on the website.

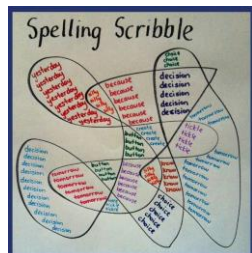

Spellings

Using the Y3/4 Common Exception words which are uploaded to the website, pick 10 that you find more difficult to remember in your writing and then carry out the following activities:

Weekly Writing Tasks

We haven't written a fiction story for a while so here's your chance.

Write an adventure story based on an evacuee leaving the city for the country. What adventure could they get up to?

Think about your character – who will it be (boy or girl)? What will they be like? How will they be feeling when they leave their parents and when they are in the countryside? etc

Think about your setting – what will the countryside be like? Where will they live? Farm? Shop? Family? etc

What adventure will they have in the countryside? Will they find treasure? Will they get lost? Will they find someone who is in hiding?

How will it end? When the adventure ends or when they go back home?
