Dear Parents,

Thank you for your support in getting the children settled back into school this year. They have made a great start and I have thoroughly enjoyed working with them this half term.

There are just a few things that I would like to let you know about the coming weeks:

### PE Days

PE lessons are currently on Friday. If children have pierced ears they need to either bring in some tape to cover them with or, ideally, take the earrings out for PE. It would be ideal for children to have both an indoor and an outdoor PE kit on those days as we will try to get outside whenever the weather allows.

### Homework
