<p style="text-align: center;">Shape</p> <p>Go on a shape hunt in your room. How many circles, squares, triangles, oblongs did you find? What other shapes did you find? Can you use them to make a pattern or draw your own shapes in a pattern. Can you use different colours and shapes? How many different shapes can you use? Is it a repeating pattern? Can someone else continue it?</p> <p>Challenge: Play the I Spy Shape Game with your family. Each person has to describe a shape they see don't forget to use the shape's properties (number of faces, vertices, edges). Everyone can have a go. The person who guess the most shapes is the winner.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Reading</p> <p>Read your school reading book daily and write it in the reading record book. This is to build up fluency and comprehension/understanding.
