# HAWSE END TRIP 17th-19th May 2017

Our forthcoming residential trip to Hawes End is fast approaching, so I have put together a few reminders.

The children's kit should be packed in a small suitcase or holdall. The children need to pack themselves or watch you packing; so that they know exactly what they are taking with them (a list inside the case can also be helpful). Disposable cameras may be taken, but the children must be responsible for them. Electrical items, specifically: mobile phones, digital cameras, tongs etc, are strictly prohibited, as are sweets. Please could you ensure that a separate rucksack/small bag is packed with a pack-up for the Wednesday lunchtime, drinks (no bottles or cans), a waterproof coat and their pocket money (maximum £5).

### **ILLNESS**

If your child is ill or suffers a minor injury, we will make sure he/she gets medical treatment. If the problem is more serious, we will contact you and either take your child to hospital or to the doctor or arrange for him/her to be collected and taken home, depending on the nature of the problem.

### MEDICATION

If your child requires medication would you please bring it on the Wednesday morning, clearly labeled with your child's name and instructions and give it to Mrs Duffy (except inhalers which we would expect the children to look after themselves and always keep with them).
