Design and Technology Week 3

Look at the powerpoint and discuss the following: How many different types of biscuits can you think of? Create a list of children's ideas. Which of these is your favourite and why?

Have you always liked the same kinds of biscuits or have your tastes changed as you have grown up?

When do you eat biscuits? Children share their ideas. Ask children to imagine that they have invited each of the people on the slides over for afternoon tea. What kind of biscuit would you offer them and why?

What do you think the most popular type of biscuits are and why? Tell children that today they will be carrying out some research to find out what kinds of biscuits people prefer.

Children to design their own questionnaire to find out about which kinds of biscuits people prefer, how often people eat biscuits and whether their taste in biscuits has changed over time. Children to ask family or friends to fill it in.

Perhaps they could email or video phone family or friends to fill this in but don't worry if you don't have many people to ask.
