Arrangements from Wednesday 6th January

The school has been asked to provide provision and care for children so parents with crucial roles during this pandemic are able to go to work. We are offering provision for your child(ren) only where it is **absolutely** necessary for you to go to work. To ensure the smooth running of the provision it is important that you keep us informed about which days you require your child to attend. We would like to stress again that if children can be cared for at home then the Government has asked that they stay at home.

We can now confirm the arrangements for the provision that will be provided for your child starting tomorrow Wednesday 6th January at North Duffield School.

Class bubbles

We will have 2 bubbles in school, one bubble will be for Class 1 and 2 pupils (KS1 Bubble) and the other for pupils in Class 3, 4 and 5 (KS2 Bubble).

Each bubble will be allocated a classroom to work in led by a teacher and supported by teaching assistants. The children will stay in the same room throughout the period of this lockdown.

Miss Williams, Mrs de Bethel and Ms Henriques will be on a rota system working with the KS1 bubble.

Mrs Mounfield, Mr Stroyd, Mrs Duffy and Mr Russell will be working with the KS2 bubble.

Please use the Broadmanor pedestrian entrance to enter the school site and follow the one-way system around school, exiting the site via the Broadmanor vehicle gate. **Under the current lockdown guidance, we must limit the number of adults accompanying pupils to one per family and the wearing of face coverings are compulsory at all times whilst on the school site.**

Provision Timings

We will be running staggered start and finish times for the bubbles to ensure social distancing and a safe start and end to the day.

KS1 Bubble (Classes 1 and 2)

Start Time- 8:50

Finish Time 3:10

Enter via the main entrance door (next to the office)

Exit from the Class 2 outside area.

KS2 Bubble (Classes 3, 4 and 5)

Start Time 9:00

Finish time 3:20

Enter and exit via the Class 3/Class 5 Cloakroom.



Please can you ensure you abide by these times.

Provision

Children will be following the same work as set for children who are home learning and will be supported with their learning by a teacher and teaching assistants. All the work is planned by their class teacher and is based on the learning they would have completed this half term.

Food

The school is able to provide a hot meal at lunchtime and we will inform you of any changes to the menu. The meals for this week are:

Children will be required to wear school uniform. They can also bring an additional, appropriate, jumper to keep warm whilst the school keeps the school well ventilated. They should also bring a PE kit as we will be doing sessions outside when the weather is fine.

Some childminders and nurseries may be following government guidelines and be offering before and after school care to the parents of key workers and vulnerable children. Little Ducks will be offering before and after school care to the parents of key workers and vulnerable children.
