## Week 3 and 4 Home Learning Packs

The staff have prepared home learning packs for the next two weeks. Each class teacher has put relevant work on the school's website for all to access including links to websites and specific resources children may need. Any resources needed will be available for collection, where possible, on Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> May from school. To ensure we abide by the government social distancing guidelines we have put the following procedure in place:

- A pack, **if you require one**, will be made available on Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> May for your child.
- Please enter the site via the pedestrian gate on Broadmanor and leave through the vehicle gate (Nursery gates will be open). No vehicles will be accessing the site during the day.
- The packs will be placed on a class table on the Broadmanor playground. A member of staff will be present if you have any questions.
- Each class will have an allocated time slot to pick up the pack, this ensures a limited amount of people on site at any one time.
- If you have more than one child in school and they are in different classes you will be able to pick up all the packs at once.
- If someone else will be picking up a pack for your child please let us know.
