The main materials we are hoping to acquire are:

Wood planks to make 5 raised beds Fencing for around the growing area Fence posts Chicken wire Hand held garden tools Large rope Tent (s) Den building materials Soil and compost Bark chipping or other suitable material to make pathways Large off-cuts of trees for seating Anything we can use to aid our outdoor learning

Even if you know a local company that may be willing to help, please pass on their names to myself so that I can contact them.
